


Club meetings are at the Knox County Extension Office

- Youth are REQUIRED to give 3-5 minute presentation at the Kentucky State Fair on August 21, 2025
- Youth must get 6 hours of classroom instruction in order to compete at the State
 Fair. We will have bi-monthly meetings after school at the Knox County Extension
 Office.
 - Hams will be hung and monitored in the ham house.
